



Fee for Water Allocation Assignments Fixed and Usage Charges

From 1 October 2006 new charges were introduced for regulated rivers and groundwater allocation assignments in accordance with the 2006 IPART Pricing Determination.

Changes relate to the minimum and maximum charge rates, as well as the charge per megalitre of water transferred and are only applicable to fees for access licences under Water Sharing Plans.

Fees remain the same for licences issued under the *Water Act 1912*, where there is no water sharing plan implemented.

Below is a summary of the fees:

Water Source	<i>Water Act 1912</i> (no change)	<i>Water Management Act 2000</i> Water Sharing Plan
Regulated Surface Licence	\$25 plus \$1/ML, to maximum of \$75	\$50 plus \$0.50/ML, to a maximum of \$150
Groundwater Licence	\$25 plus \$1/ML, to maximum of \$75	\$50 plus \$0.50/ML, to a maximum of \$150

Valley Water Allocation Assignment forms (previously called Temporary Transfers) can be accessed on the State Water Website, www.statewater.com.au. Please select Water Delivery, choose the appropriate form that is applicable to your licence and then pick the relevant valley application form.

Allocation Assignments must be submitted on the correct form, as wrong forms will be returned for amendment. Please ensure the fee is correctly calculated using the new charges and attached to the form.
