

Water Orders on the Hunter River

21 January 2009

State Water requests that water users on the Hunter River and Glennies Creek place water orders in advance of their pumping needs.

It is a requirement for water license holders to place orders before they pump water from the river.

Many water users are not ordering their water and as a result water has not been available for users who have legitimately placed an order.

State Water must meet regulatory river flow requirements as well as legitimate water orders. It is very difficult to do both if water users just take water when they want to without first putting an order in for a release of water from the dams.
